These were some of the items discussed.

Progress and impact of the merger with Dean & Reddyhoff: The merger has progressed well since the announcement and QM/DR will be making some changes over the next few months.

Dredging Programme: QM expect to catch up at the current rate of progress and Area 2 is expected to be on time. CMBHA pointed out that some berths on A, B & C legs were becoming shallower but they will be dredged next Winter as part of the scheduled annual dredging programme.

Member Benefits: QM would continue to offer a variety of benefits to CMBHA members and asked for a wish list for them to consider.

Waste Pump-out: QM explained that although the waste pump-out is now working the old discharge piping needs to be replaced and this will be carried out over the winter period.
