

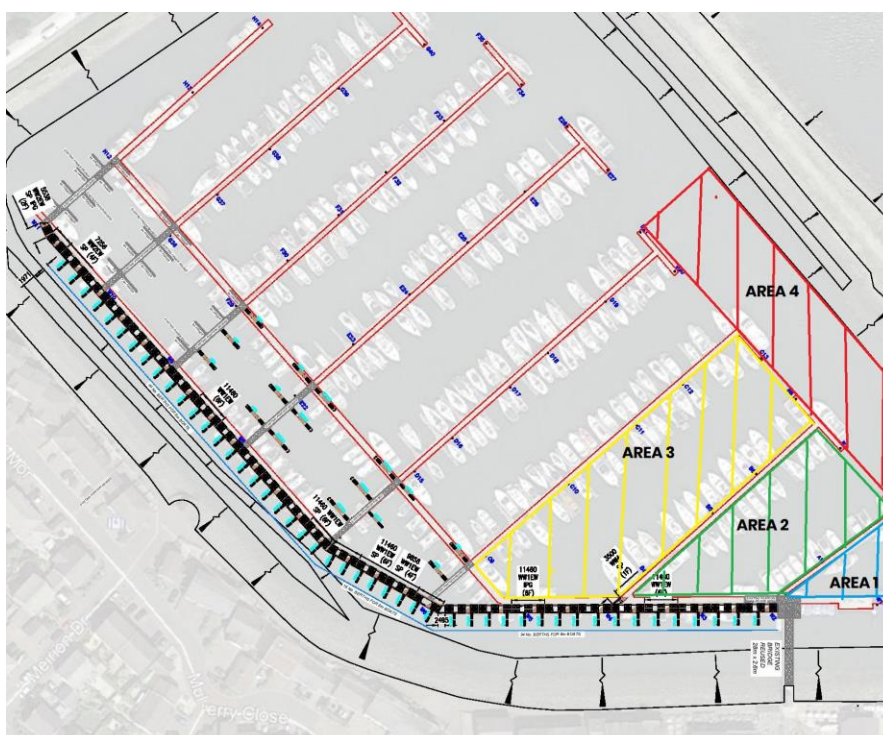

2020 Conwy Marina Dredging Campaign

- Site preparation works for Areas 1 & 2 are now completed
- Dredging started w/c 9th November 2020.
- Scheduled dredging sequence by Area.
- Dredging scheduled to last approximately 4-months.
- Dredging operations will normally run between Monday and Friday to allow vessels free passage over a weekend, however because of tides, weather and other statutory restrictions, there will be some weekends where dredging will be taking place.
- Some access restrictions will occur during the works.
- Any vessels relocated for dredging by Conwy Marina staff will be notified of their temporary berth number by email.
- Owners of vessels with ready-made lines are requested to remove them and replace with ordinary mooring lines.
- Any dock fenders or fixed lines left on the marina berth or walkway are so at the owner's risk.
- Electricity supply remains subject to availability. Owners are responsible for transferring electric once vessels have been relocated.
- We reserve the right to modify the dredging sequence without advance notification.
- Regular updates will be provided via Conwy Marina Smartlist & Social media.
