

CMBHA Newsletter January 2022

We hope that CMBHA can help you to have a brilliant 2022 boating season.

The meeting with Boatfolk in December went quite well in December. The minutes are on the CMBHA web site on the Boatfolk Interactions page [Boatfolk interactions - Conwy Marina And Berth Holders Association \(cmbha.net\)](https://cmbha.net/boatfolk-interactions-conwy-marina-and-berth-holders-association). The discussion included a dredging update, lighting on I leg, the availability of power sockets on pontoons and the boatyard, and tide/gate information for January to March 2022. Boatfolk mentioned that many berth holders had not removed their sails or summer boat covers. There is also the hazard of untied webbing being very dangerous for Boatfolk staff when patrolling pontoons in very high winds.

In 2016, CMBHA applied to the British Heart Foundation for a contribution for a defibrillator at Conwy Marina. The application was supported and funded by the marina, The Mulberry, the local housing community and of course CMBHA. Since then, the marina has taken responsibility for its upkeep. The December meeting touched on whether the AED (Automated External Defibrillator) was still properly registered with the emergency services and whether anything needed replacement. After the meeting CMBHA confirmed that it was registered and that the Ambulance Trust would supply a replacement battery and pads.

The next CMBHA Committee meeting will be on Zoom on Monday, January 10th. The agenda will include the 2022 AGM and events for the beginning of the season.
