

The Conwy River Festival is here again.

The CRF La La Rally is essentially a cruise to Caernarvon starting on Friday 8th July and returning on the Sunday. There are currently 31 boats going and you can find out more and book your place at [Conwy River Festival](#) until mid-day on Thursday or until the Rally is full with 40 boats booked. It's a great way of enjoying some of the most spectacular scenery North Wales can offer and making a whole batch of new friends. Power boats, as well as sailing boats are welcome.

The CRF Racing Weekend on 16th-17th July weekend is family-friendly. The class 1 race will be the traditional form of start line racing with everybody starting at the same time. The class 2 will be a pursuit race. This means that the slower boats start first and the faster boats start progressively later. This leads to much less stress at the start line. These races are great fun as your position in the race is clear and it's less of a procession: the faster boats don't just sail off into the distance and the slower boats are involved in the race throughout.

On the Sunday night there will be cup presentations in the Comrades Club in Conwy with food and entertainment - is all included in the modest entry fee, subsidised by festival sponsors.
