



Conwy Marina – Fire Safety Guidance for Berth Holders

In the event of a fire on a boat within the marina:

1. Raise the Alarm

- Shout **"FIRE"** to alert others nearby.
- Use the **fire alarms**:
 - Located on the **main walkway SOS bollards**.
 - One is also fitted to the **green hut at the bottom of the access bridge**.
- Call **999** and ask for the **Fire Service**. State **Conwy Marina, basin**.
- If you can, use the **what3words app** to provide an exact location of the fire.
- If you have a VHF radio, call the **Coastguard on Channel 16**.

2. Keep Yourself Safe

- Do **not** attempt to tackle the fire unless it is very small and you feel confident using the nearest extinguisher.
- Move away from the fire. If on a pontoon, head to the shore.
- If you cannot leave the pontoon safely, go to the **hammerhead (end of pontoon)** where you can be evacuated by boat.

3. Evacuation Point

- The assembly point for all berth holders is the **Mulberry Pub car park** near the substation.

4. Important Reminders

- Never re-enter the marina or your boat until the Fire Service confirms it is safe.
- Follow the instructions of marina staff and emergency services at all times.
- Keep access ways clear for emergency crews.
